What am I agreeing to?

I understand

- by signing this agreement, I agree to my child participating in video calls that will be accessed by Zoom
- my child needs a safe and appropriate place to do remote learning. When on any video calls with school, it would be better not to be in a bedroom but where this is unavoidable, my child will be fully dressed and not in bed, and the camera angle will point away from beds/bedding/personal information etc. Where it is possible to blur or change the background, I will help my child to do so
- where my child is participating in live streaming sessions that these will be recorded and stored on a secure system in school for one year
- I will need to ensure that my child does not record any of the recorded or live sessions on their phone and share online and/or social media
- my child needs to behave appropriately online in a session delivered by video link in the same way as if they were in school with the member of staff. If a pupil behaves inappropriately, we may suspend their Google account temporarily
- family members should be out of camera shot and do not contribute to the video call
- I am to ensure that my child is familiar with how the process works such as muting when my child is not speaking and logging in
- I am to ensure that the appropriate language is used by all members of the household for the duration of the call
- parents/carers are prohibited from recording or capturing/screen grabbing content from the video call or distributing it to others
- parents/carers are prohibited from entering into chats with other pupils without a teacher present
- parents/carers are prohibited from copying and distributing class codes or log in information
- that if my child is the only child in the session then the session cannot go ahead, and the teacher will provide support on Google Classroom instead
- I am to promote positive online safety and model safe, responsible, and positive behaviours in my own use of technology, including on social media: not sharing other's images or details without permission and refraining from posting negative, threatening or violent comments about others, including the school staff, volunteers, governors, contractors, pupils or other parents/carers

Pupils

- I do not behave differently when I am learning at home, so I do not say or do things I would not do in the classroom.
- my phone is not switched on when I am taking part in a live video link or is given to my teacher when in school. It is not used to record or screen grab content from a recorded or live session
- I am a friend online and will not share or say anything that I know would upset another person or they would not want shared.
- I am a secure online learner and keep my passwords to myself and reset them if anyone finds them out. Friends do not share passwords!
- I dress appropriately when online
- I remain on mute until invited to speak
- I must use kind words at all times
