# Spring Term

#### **Great Explorers!**

This term in Year 1, the children will be learning about themselves. The children will be encouraged to explore and develop their understanding of themselves and the world they live in.

This term in Year 1, the children will learn about travelling around the world and into space using different methods of research. In the first half of the term, we will be looking at space travel and Neil Armstrong. In the second half of the term, we will be looking at Christopher Columbus. We will also invent pirate treasure maps using symbols and keys. The children will read their map to find clues for a treasure hunt around the school and will create their own pirate hat.

This term in Year 1, the children will learn about different countries, cultures and lifestyles. We will be using three different stories to explore other cultures and they will then compare it to their own way of life. In the second half of the term, they will look at animal and plant life. We will end the term by creating a 3D rainforest.
