<p>Fire! Fire!</p> <p>This half term in Year 2, we will be learning about the Great Fire of London. The children will become historians as they learn about Samuel Pepys and how his diary helped us to learn about the events of the Great Fire of London. We will use our art skills to create our own painting of the Great Fire.</p>	<p>Antarctic Adventures</p> <p>This half term in Year 2, we will be learning about the explorer, Captain Scott, who travelled to the Antarctic. As geographers, the children will learn about two different settlements, hot and cold, and what is essential to survive across any setting. After looking at Antarctica, the children will make their own moving picture using skills taught in DT.</p>	<p>To India and Back Again</p> <p>This term in Year 2 we will be learning about India. The children will study geographical similarities and differences of a small area of the United Kingdom and of a small area in India. We will be using a range of non-fiction texts to support our learning in English, to be fully immersed in the knowledge of India and the United Kingdom.</p> <p>They will also be exploring printing during art lessons. This will involve using a variety of materials to create simple images and improve and build upon simple printing skills from the previous year.</p> <p>In the later part of the term, the children will learn a new skill; sewing, in DT lessons. They will become more confident with their new skill and eventually will create their own animal hand puppet.</p>	<p>Colossal Castles</p> <p>This term in Year 2, we will be learning about Castles. The children will learn what life was like in a castle, the features of a castle and the use of castles today. As historians, the children will use their enquiry skill to learn about William I, ask questions about the Battle of Hastings and interpret the Bayeux Tapestry.</p> <p>In Art lessons, the children will use the skill of observational drawing to sketch a castle using a range of equipment such as pencil, charcoal, oil pastels and crayons. They will be building on their observational skills from the previous year where they drew portraits. They will be able to compare different techniques used and say their preference, giving examples using their own work.</p>
