Thank you for your understanding with regards to the drop off and collection for today. This will be in effect on Monday also. As a reminder drop off and collection should be as follows:





Alfie Hewett OBE

<u>Who is Alfie Hewett?</u>



Alfie Hewett is a British professional wheelchair tennis player. He was born in Norwich on the 6^{th} December 1997. At the age of 6 years old, Alfie was diagnosed with a condition that affected the blood supply to his thigh bones. He started to play wheelchair tennis in 2005 at the age of 8.

What has Alfie achieved?



Alfie is an incredibly successful wheelchair tennis player who plays both singles and doubles. He has won a total of 18 Grand Slams in his career so far. He is also a double Paralympic silver medalist. In January 2018, at the age of 20, he became world No. 1 for the very first time.
